

Michelle Berlin, MD, MPH is Vice Chair of the OHSU Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology, Associate Director of the OHSU Center for Women's Health and Director of the National Center of Excellence in Women's Health at OHSU. Dr. Berlin is one of the few obstetrician-gynecologists in the United States who is also fully trained in preventive medicine. She joined OHSU in 2001, from the University of Pennsylvania. She was as an Associate Editor at the Annals of Internal Medicine from 1996-2002, and has performed work for the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force.

Among her current responsibilities, she teaches within the OHSU Human Investigations Program, is a member of the Institutional Review Board (IRB) and provides mentorship and research opportunities to students and faculty within OHSU. She is a primary author of "Making the Grade on Women's Health: A National and State-by-State Report Card."

In 2009, she was named a Woman Leader of Oregon by New Leadership Oregon. Dr. Berlin also serves as Program Director of the CWH's Policy Advisory Towards Health (PATH for women), focusing on health policy issues within women's health.
