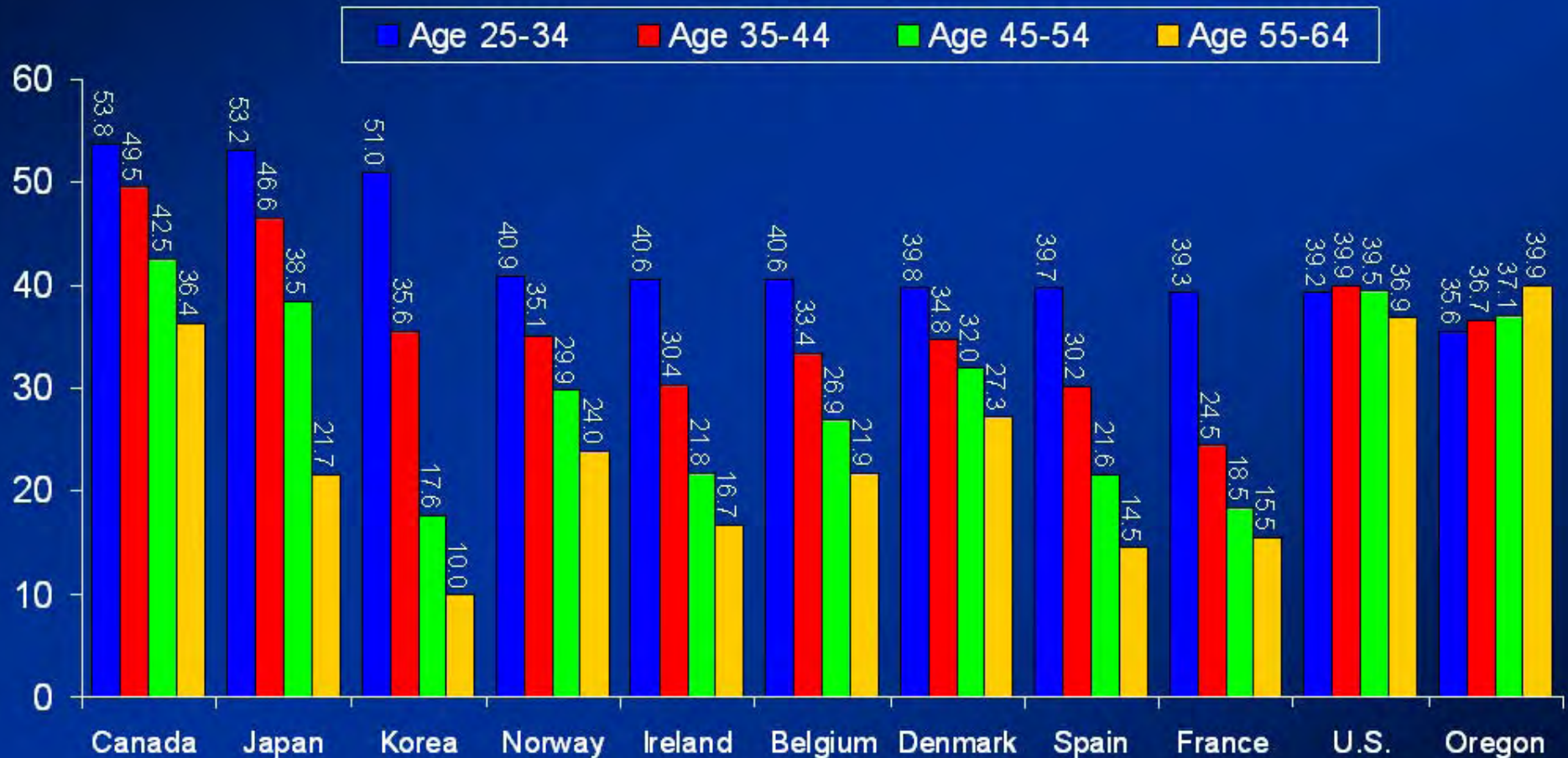

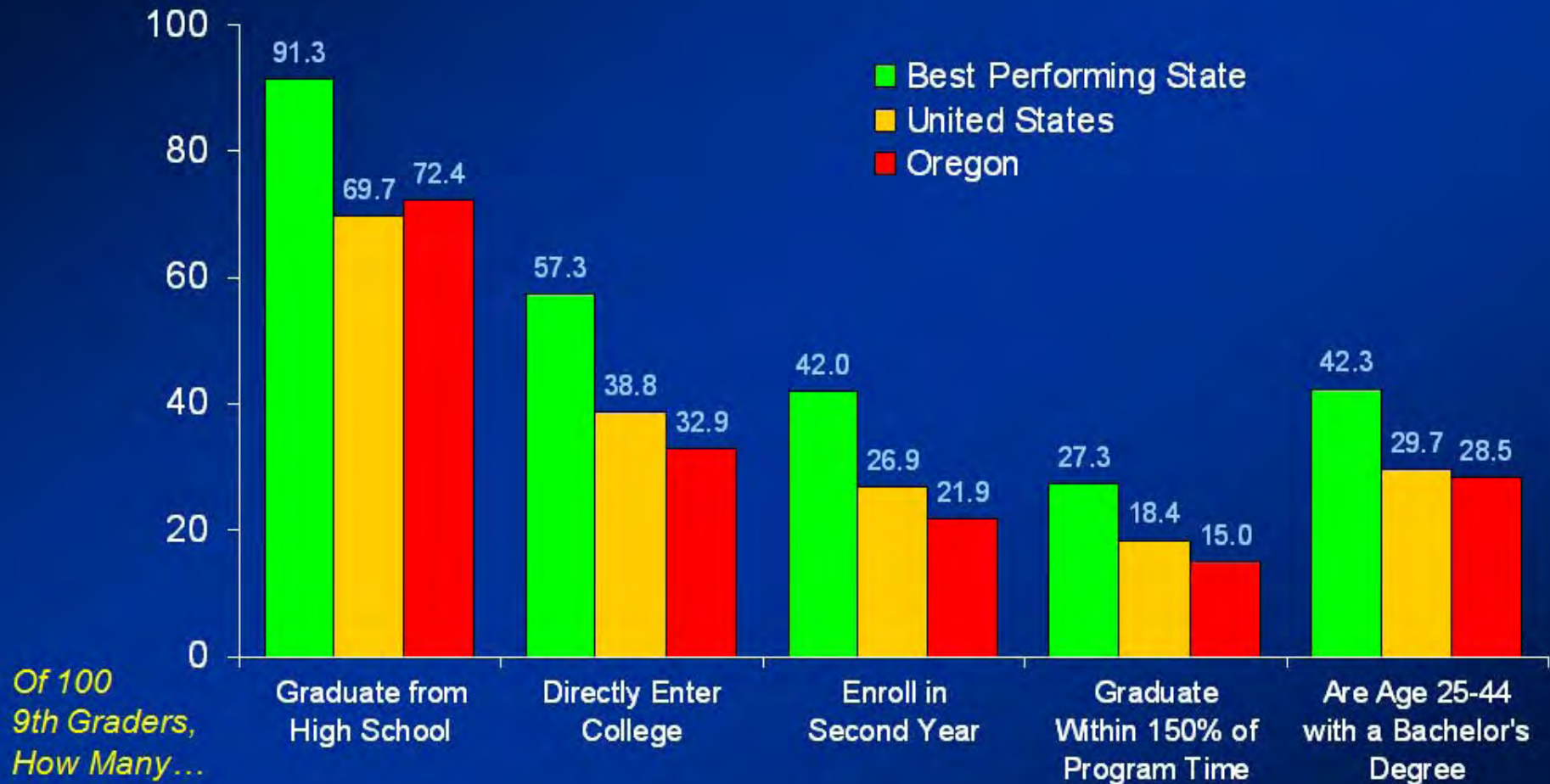

Percent of Adults with an Associate Degree or Higher by Age Group—Oregon, U.S. and Leading OECD Countries



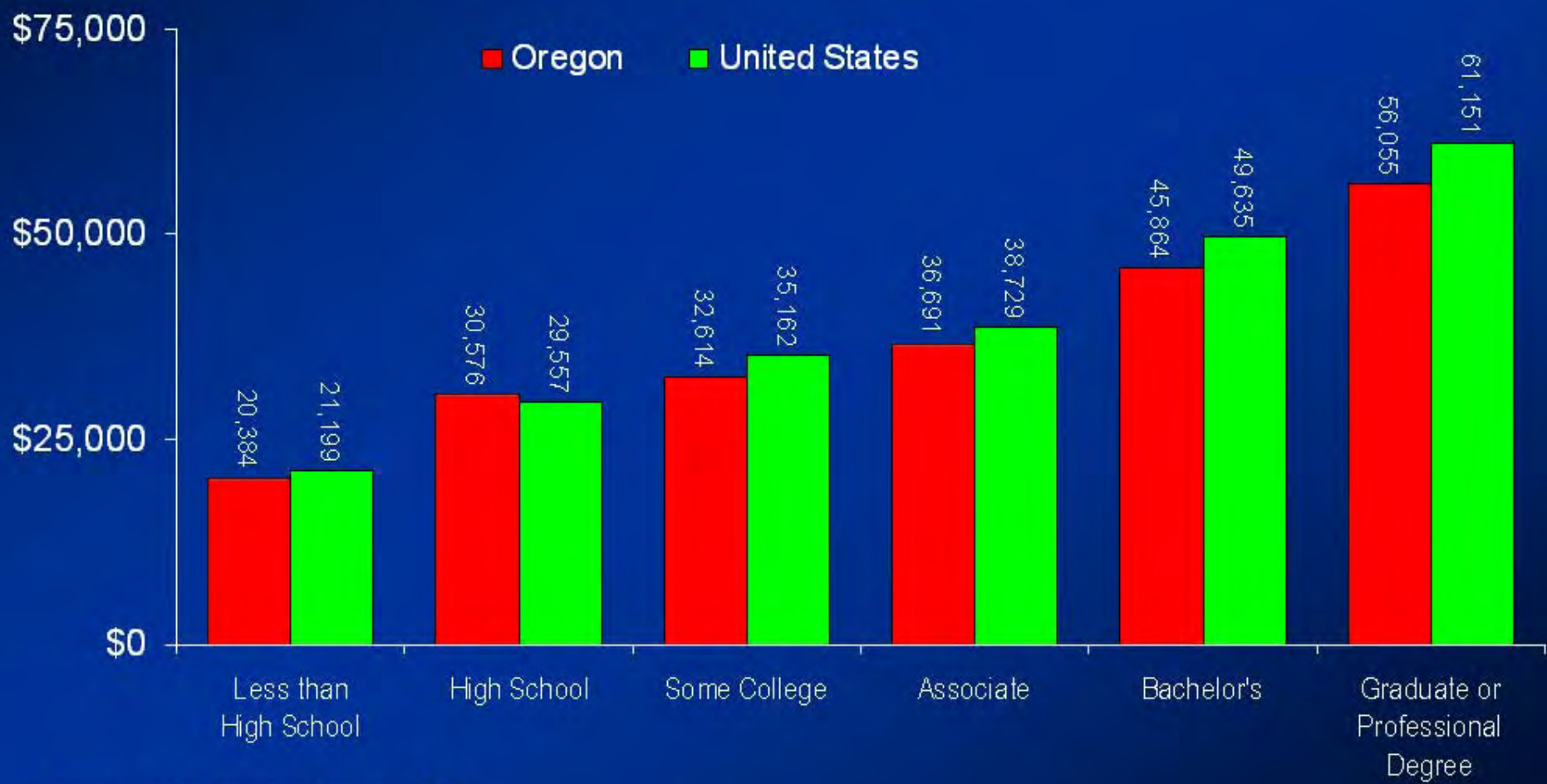

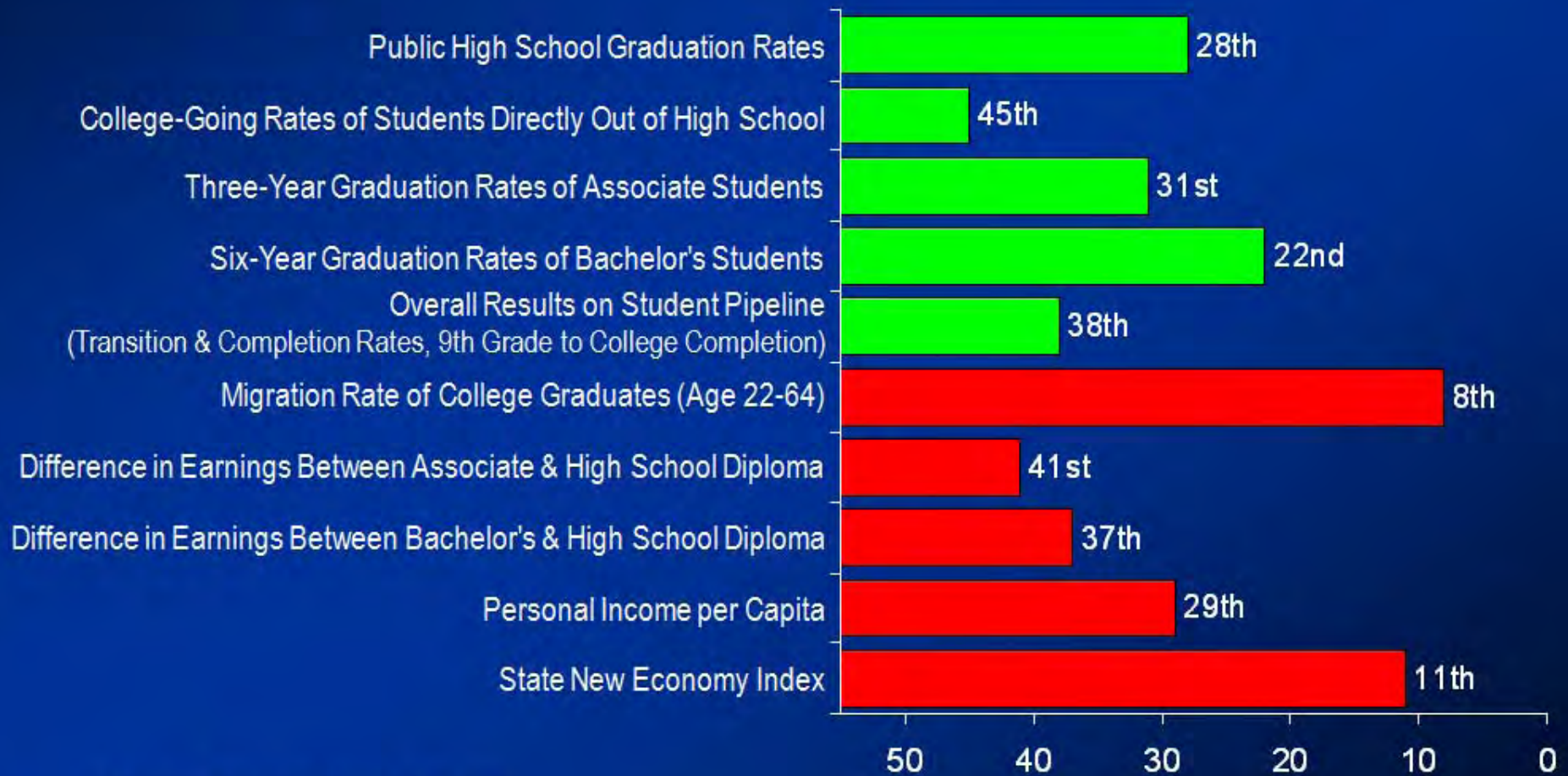
Median Earnings of Population Age 25-64 by Level of Education, 2005
